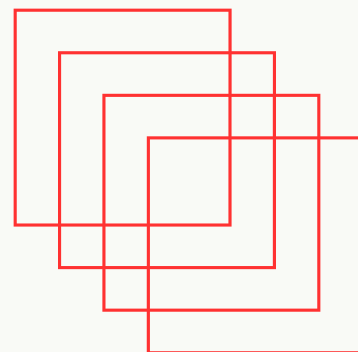

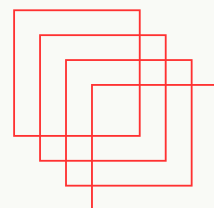

The year of birth is used to determine the age; Every age category begins counting on January 1. In the duo and trio categories, the younger dancer must participate in the category of the older dancer. The average age is calculated for groups, but if you have big age difference in your groups, please email us so we could help you with the registration.

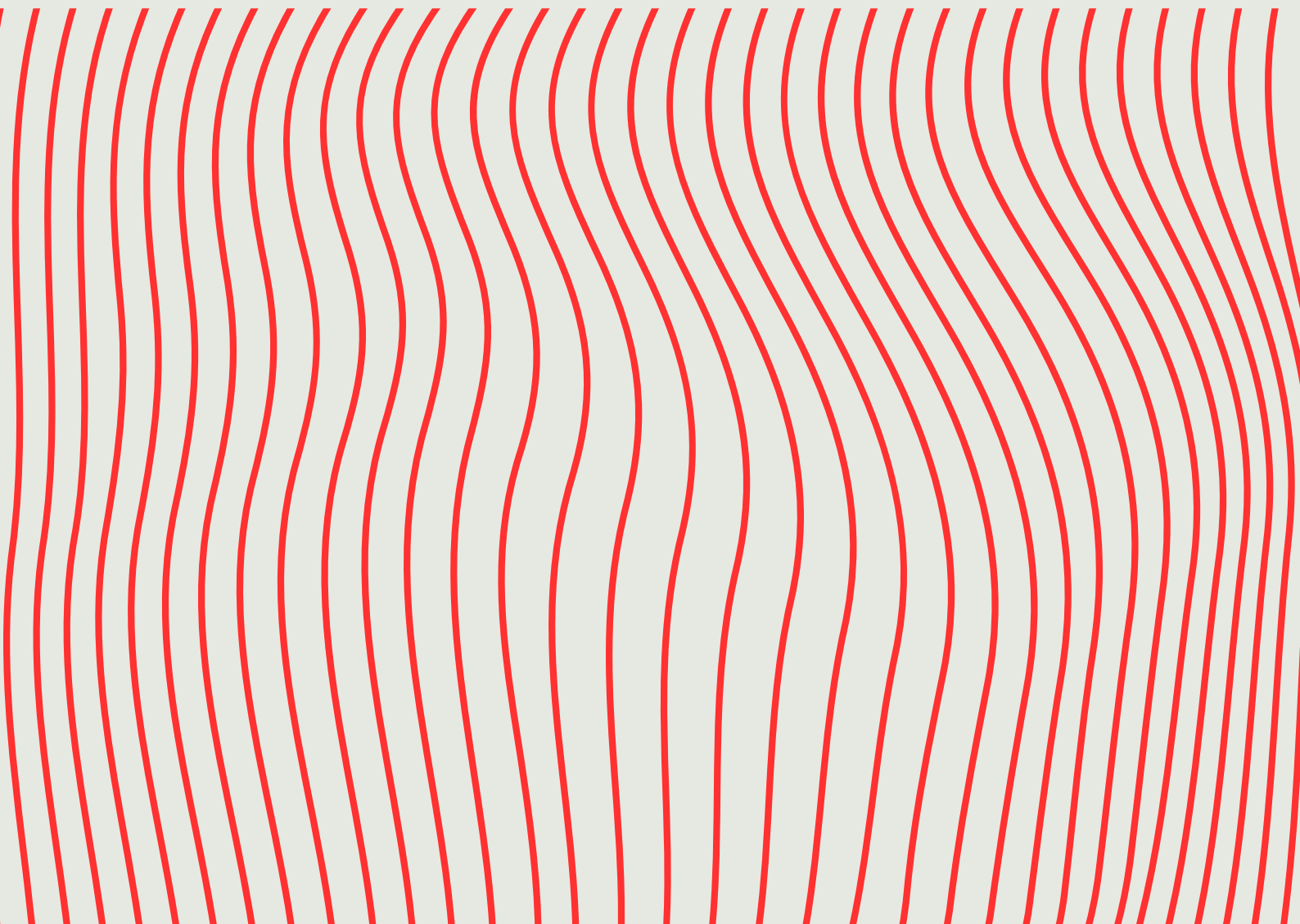

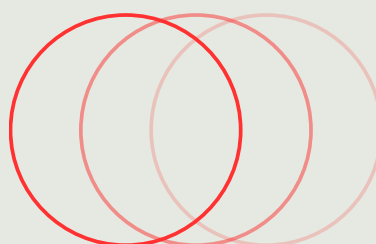
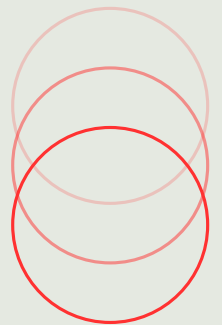

Photo&Video

Photography and recording with professional equipment is strictly prohibited! Failure to follow this rule may result in disqualification from the dance club. The event will be covered by a professional media team, and you will be able to buy photos and recordings of the choreography on the spot.

Clubs that order more packages get a discount.

Check-In

Check-in is located at the entrance to the theater. Your club representative is responsible for check-in. Each team receives one coach's pass per 10 dancers!



General information

An unofficial schedule will be posted 2-5 days after the registration deadline. You will be able to make changes by following the instructions we will provide.

Competitors must be ready at the theater at least 30-45 minutes before the performance. The theater opens 1 hour before the first performance. Check-in begins 45 minutes before the competition begins.
